## The Position of Associate Director

TEAMS for Medical Missions *is a growing mission agency that exists to strengthen the Church in Jamaica, West Indies.*

*It is an independent faith mission board with year-round ministries including medical work, evangelism, discipling and leadership training ministries, construction and relief work.*

TEAMS for Medical Missions seeks a full-time missionary to serve as Associate Director.

The new Associate Director will be of Biblically conservative, evangelical faith, with some formal theological and Bible training. He or she will be an example of consistent Christian living, a person of prayer, and one who obeys, upholds, and teaches the Bible as inspired by God and the sufficient and final authority for belief and life.

The new Associate Director will be passionate for missions and evangelism and proven in successful missionary and/or local church ministry. He or she should have some cross-cultural missionary experience and through personal contact should understand the character and work of TEAMS.

Depending on qualifications and other factors, the new Associate Director could eventually step into the role of Executive Director. For this reason, from the outset, she or he will be collaborative and visionary in leadership. This person will assist the current Executive Director as he leads and oversees every aspect of TEAMS for Medical Missions – this includes all aspects of planning, development, promotion and administration. He or she will help implement the forthcoming strategic plan and assist in overseeing a growing annual budget, currently at \$400,000.

The new Associate Director will guide and supervise the TEAMS home office, field and volunteer staff of approximately 100 active participants each year. She or he will foster a USA-Jamaica network of missionaries, J-Team and other volunteers, churches and church leaders, praying people and financial contributors, and will cultivate new ways to extend the mission of TEAMS.

The new Associate Director will report to the Executive Director of TEAMS for Medical Missions and work from both the Allentown, Pennsylvania home office and the TEAMS-Jamaica field. This means that he or she must be available to travel for purposes of leading J-Teams, for encouraging and supervising TEAMS-Jamaica field missionaries, and to promote TEAMS for Medical Missions in the USA..

All leadership personnel at TEAMS for Medical Missions are on missionary support. This means that their salaries are set by the TEAMS Board of Directors and supplied to the missionaries through TEAMS by friends, families, and churches who desire to be part of his or her ministry through regular financial gifts.
